## **Step 2: Enter Your Submission Details**

*A successful ACCP Conference Session will:*

1. **Present a distinctive approach or strategy** that highlights what was innovative, what was learned, and how challenges were navigated with transparency and relatability.
2. **Demonstrate strategy + impact** and features the inputs, outputs, and outcomes, providing a 360° perspective.
3. **Deliver tangible, transferable takeaways**, tools, frameworks, or templates that attendees can adapt to their own organization or role immediately.
4. **Create meaningful engagement**, whether through facilitated discussion, interactive elements, or moments for participants to reflect, analyze, or apply concepts. Attendees should feel a part of the session rather than an observer of it.
5. **Connect insights to broader CSR trends and business priorities**, helping practitioners understand relevance, implications, and potential impact.
