

ACCP Exhibitor Bingo

ACCP 2024 Annual Conference attendees will have the opportunity to participate in ACCP Exhibitor Bingo taking place between Sunday, September 8, 2024 – Tuesday, September 10, 2024.

Below are details on how to participate in the ACCP Exhibitor Bingo.

Official Rules

1. **Introduction:** The Association of Corporate Citizenship Professionals (ACCP) (“Sponsor”) is conducting a challenge contest (“Contest”) at the ACCP 2024 Annual Conference (“Conference”) for an opportunity to win exclusive prizes.
2. **NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.** Void where prohibited by law and outside of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia. Subject to all federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received and the participation of each entry. Prizes will be awarded to two randomly selected cards from submitted from Sunday, September 8 at 4:00 PM PDT to Tuesday, September 10 at 5:00 PM PDT (“Contest Period”). ACCP’s computer is the official time-keeping device for this Contest.
3. **Eligibility:** The ACCP Annual Conference 2024 ACCP Exhibitor Bingo is open to legal U.S. residents currently residing in the 50 United States including the District of Columbia who are at least 18 years of age as of the date of entry and who attend the Conference where the Contest is offered and permitted by law. Employees, officers, and directors of ACCP (“Sponsor”) or any of its parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, representatives, consultants, contractors, legal counsel, advertising, public relations, promotional, fulfillment, and marketing agencies, website providers, web masters, and all other companies or entities associated with the Contest, including Conference sponsors, exhibitors, vendors and Prize Sponsor(s), as may be further defined herein, (collectively, the “Contest Entities”), and members of their immediate families (spouses, parents, siblings and children, regardless of where they live) and those living in the same household are not eligible to enter or win. Participation constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and to ACCP’s decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. Sponsor reserves the right to verify the eligibility of winners.
4. **How to Enter:** All conference attendees that check in to ACCP’s 2024 Annual Conference at the Marriott Marquis San Diego Marina AND do the following are entered into the contest:
 - a) Attendees can pick up an ACCP Exhibitor Bingo card from the designated table.
 - b) Attendees will have the opportunity to visit ACCP sponsor’s exhibit tables. At these tables, attendees will ask questions, to match the squares on the card.

- c) Attendees will write the exhibitor company name in the square on the card when the correct answer is received.
- d) Attendees must clearly write contact information on the back of the card, including name, email address and phone number.
- e) When attendees complete a row, the card can be submitted in the box on the designated table.

5. **Selection of winners: Of those that submit, two cards will be randomly selected.** Winners will be announced on Tuesday, September 10, 2024. No duplicate winners are allowed. The Winner need not be present to win. In the event the same name is randomly selected for both challenges, that winning name will have the opportunity to select their preferred prize, and then an alternate random name will be drawn for the other challenge.

6. **Prizes:** Two prizes will be awarded, by sponsor, as follows:

Sponsor and its agencies are not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, damaged, stolen, misdirected, or illegible entries; lost, interrupted, or unavailable network, server, or other connections, garbled transmissions or miscommunications, telephone transmission problems; computer or software malfunctions or damage to a user's computer equipment (software or hardware); technical failures; or other errors or malfunctions of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, or otherwise. Proof of sending or submission of entry will not be deemed proof of receipt by Sponsor. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

By participating, entrants and winner(s) agree to release and hold harmless ACCP, its subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotions agencies, partners, representatives, agents, successors, assigns, employees, officers, directors, and volunteers from any and all liability for loss, harm, damage, injury, cost, or expense whatsoever including, without limitation, property damage, personal injury, and/or death that may occur in connection with, preparation for, travel to, or participation in Contest, or possession, acceptance, and/or use or misuse of prize or participation

in any Contest-related activity, and for any claims based on publicity rights, defamation, invasion of privacy, and merchandize delivery.
